Go, attack the Amalekites and <u>totally destroy everything</u> that belongs to them. Do not spare them; put to death men and women, children and infants, cattle and sheep, camels and donkeys."<sup>4</sup> So Saul summoned the men... kites. <sup>7</sup>Then Saul attacked the Amalekites... <sup>8</sup> He took Agag king of the Amalekites alive, and all his people he totally destroyed with the sword. <sup>9</sup> But Saul and the army spared Agag and the best of the sheep and cattle, the fat calves and lambs—everything that was good. These they were unwilling to destroy completely, but everything that was despised and weak they totally destroyed. **1 Samuel 15:3-9** (NIV)

But now your kingdom must end, for the LORD has sought out a man after His own heart. ...because you have not kept the LORD's command." 1 Samuel 13:14 (NIrV)

Later, God removed Saul and let David rule in his place. God said about him, "David the son of Jesse is the kind of person who pleases me most! He does everything I want him to do." Act 13:22 (CEV)

So why did you not obey GOD? Why did you grab all this loot? Why, with GOD's eyes on you... did you brazenly carry out this evil?" <sup>20</sup> <u>Saul defended himself</u>. "What are you talking about? I did obey GOD. I did the job GOD set for me. I brought in King Agag and destroyed the Amalekites under the terms of the holy ban. **1 Samuel 15:3-9** (MP)

*But* <u>my</u> <u>men</u> did not kill the best sheep and cattle...; they brought them... to offer as a sacrifice to the LORD your God." **1 Samuel 15:3-9** (GNB)

"It was <u>the woman You gave</u> me who gave me the fruit, and I ate it." **Genesis 3:12** (NLT)
