AN EFFECTIVE SHIELD OF FAITH REQUIRES TWO COMPONENTS:

1. A PERSONAL BELIEF IN

Faith is the assurance (title deed, confirmation) of things hoped for, and the evidence of things not seen [the conviction of their reality). Hebrews 11:1 (AMP)

Paul replied, "No, Your Excellency Festus, I am not crazy. I speak words of truth and reason. ²⁶ King Agrippa, I know I can speak frankly and freely with you, for you understand these matters well, and none of these things have escaped your notice. After all, it's not like it was a secret!" Acts 26:25-26 (TPT)

2. A PERSONAL BELIEF IN

1. I CHECK OUT ______.

These are written so that you can believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God. Then, by believing, you can have life through his name. John 20:31 (ERV)

2. I CONNECT WITH ______

Remember your leaders. They spoke God's word to you. Think about the results of their way of life. Copy their faith. **Hebrews 13:7** (NIrV)

3. I COMMIT TO

Whoever is willing to do what God wants will know whether what I teach comes from God or whether I speak on my own authority. John 7:17 (GNB)
