FOUR SECRETS OF GROWING STRONG, STABLE, AND RESILIENT

Secret 1: Heartwood –

So above all, guard the affections of your heart, for they affect all that you are. Pay attention to the welfare of your innermost being, for from there flows the wellspring of life. **Proverbs 4:23** (TPT)

Secret 3: Roots –

*I want them to be encouraged and knit together by strong ties of love.* **Colossians 2:2** (NLT)

All the believers met together constantly and shared everything with each other... They worshipped together regularly at the Temple each day, met in small groups in homes for communion, and shared their meals with great joy and thankfulness." Acts 2:44,46 (TLB)

Be careful, brothers and sisters, that none of you ever develop a wicked, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God. <sup>13</sup> Encourage each other every day while you have the opportunity. If you do this, none of you will be deceived by sin and become stubborn. **Hebrews 3:12, 13** (GW)

Secret 4: Regenerative Cells –

*We never give up. Our bodies are gradually dying, but we ourselves are being made stronger each day.* **2 Corinthians 4:16** (CEV)
