> 4 REASONS TO BE HUMBLE AND ASK FOR HELP

1. Because humbly asking for help makes me more

We don't have a priest who is out of touch with our reality. He's been through weakness and testing, experienced it all - all but the sin. So let's walk right up to him and get what he is so ready to give. Take the mercy, accept the help. **Hebrews 4:15-16** (MP)

2. Because humbly asking for help makes me more

They . . . gave me vinegar for my thirst. Psalm 69:21 (NIV)

There they offered Jesus wine to drink, mixed with gall; but after tasting it, he refused to drink it. Matthew 27:34 (NIV)

My throat is as dry as dust, and my tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth. You have left me for dead in the dust. Psalm 22:15 (GNB)
