Keep putting into practice all you learned and received from me--everything you heard from me and saw me doing. Then the God of peace will be with you. **Philippians 4:9a** (NCV)

Paul went...to Lystra, where there was a young disciple named Timothy. His mother was a Jewish believer, his father was a Greek. ² Timothy was well thought of by the believers in Lystra and Iconium, ³ so Paul wanted him to join them on their journey...
⁴Then they went from town to town **Acts 16:3-4** (NLT)

And he chose twelve men and called them apostles. He wanted these twelve men to be with him, and he wanted to send them to other places to tell people God's message **Mark 3:14** (ERV)
