1. I choose to ______.

These are the words of him who has the sharp, <u>double-edged</u> <u>sword</u>. Revelation 2:12 (NIV)

God's word.. is sharper than any two-edged sword and cuts as deep as the place where soul and spirit meet.. ¹² God's word judges a person's thoughts and intentions. **Hebrews 4:11-12** (GW)

For a time is coming when people will no longer listen to right teaching. They will follow their own desires and will look for teachers who will tell them whatever they want to hear. ⁴ They will reject <u>the truth</u> and follow <u>strange myths</u>. **2 Timothy 4:3-4** (NLT)

...the work of Satan displayed in all kinds of counterfeit miracles, signs and wonders, ¹⁰and in every sort of evil that deceives those who are perishing. They perish because <u>they refused to love the truth</u> and so be saved. **2 Thessalonians 2:9-10** (NIV)

2. I choose to ______false teaching.

I have this against you: You tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess. By her teaching she misleads my servants... **Revelation 2:20** (NIV)

Anyone who does not stay with the teaching of Christ, but goes beyond it, does not have God. Whoever does stay with the teaching has both the Father and the Son. ¹⁰So then, if someone comes to you who does not bring this teaching, do not welcome him or her in your homes; do not even say, "Peace be with you." **2 John 9-10** (CEV)

He must be devoted to the trustworthy message we teach. Then he can use these accurate teachings to encourage people and correct those who oppose the word. **Titus 1:9** (GW)

3. I choose to realize the ______.

Likewise you also have those who hold to the teaching of the Nicolaitans. ¹⁶Repent therefore! Otherwise, I will soon come to you and <u>will fight</u> <u>against them</u> with the sword of my mouth. **Revelation 2:15-16** (NIV)

You tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess ²²So I will cast her on a bed of suffering, and I will make those who commit adultery with her <u>suffer intensely</u>, unless they repent of her ways. ²³I will <u>strike her children dead</u>. **Revelation 2:20-23** (NIV)

...but part of what he says is hard to understand. Some ignorant and unsteady <u>people even destroy themselves</u> by twisting what he said. They do the same thing with other Scriptures too. **2 Peter 3:14** (CEV)
