2. Their story calls me to ______

It has given me great joy to find some of your children <u>walking in the truth</u>, just as the Father commanded us. **2 John 4** (NIV)

Jesus said to the people who believed in Him, "You are truly My disciples if you <u>remain</u> faithful to My teachings." John 8:31 (NLT)

And now, dear lady, I am not writing you a new command but one we have had from the beginning. I ask that we love one another. ⁶ And this is love: that we walk in obedience to his commands. As you have heard from the beginning, his command is that you walk in love. **2 John 5-6** (NIV)

"If you love me, keep my commands … ²¹ Whoever has my commands and <u>keeps</u> <u>them</u> is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love them and show myself to them …" ²³ Jesus replied, "Anyone who <u>loves me</u> will <u>obey</u> my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them. ²⁴ Anyone who <u>does not love me</u> will <u>not</u> <u>obey</u> my teaching. These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me. John 14: 15, 21, 23-24 (NIV)

Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says. James 1:22 (NIV)

I say this because <u>many deceivers</u>, who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh, have gone out into the world. Any such person is the deceiver and the antichrist. ⁸ Watch out that you do not lose what we have worked for, but that you may be rewarded fully. ⁹ <u>Anyone who runs ahead and does not continue in the teaching of Christ does not have God</u>; whoever continues in the teaching has both the Father and the Son. ¹⁰ If anyone comes to you and does not bring this teaching, do not take them into your house or welcome them. ¹¹ Anyone who welcomes them shares in their wicked work. **2** John 7 -11 (NIV)

LIE #3: "My	doesn't matter as long as I believe in God."
