

## • WEEK ONE – GOD, YOU ARE MY HOPE

What we are suffering now is nothing compared with our future glory. <sup>19</sup> Everything God created looks forward to the future. That will be the time when his children appear in their full and final glory! **Romans 8:18-19** (NIrV)

• WEEK TWO – GOD, YOU ARE FAITHFUL

...all creation groans in unison ... up until now. <sup>23</sup> And there is more; it's not just creation—all of us are groaning together too. Though we have already tasted the firstfruits of the Spirit, we are longing for the total redemption of our bodies that comes when our adoption as children of God is complete— <sup>24</sup> for we have been saved in this hope and for this future. But hope does not involve what we already have or see. For who goes around hoping for what he already has? <sup>25</sup> But if we wait expectantly for things we have never seen, then we hope with true perseverance and eager anticipation. **Romans 8:22-25** (VOICE)

• WEEK THREE – GOD, YOU ARE HERE

In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groans that words cannot express. <sup>27</sup>And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with God's will. **Romans 8:26-27** (NIV)

6. It does teach that God wants my story to end \_\_\_\_\_

And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, <u>he also</u> justified; those he justified, <u>he also glorified</u>. **Romans 8:30** (NIV)

And then, after getting them established, he stayed with them to the end, gloriously completing what he had begun. **Romans 8:30** (MP)
