WAS THE FIRST GREAT CHURCH PLANTING CHURCH.

Peter said much more to warn them. He urged, "Save vourselves from this corrupt generation." ⁴¹ Those who accepted what Peter said were baptized. That day about 3,000 people were added \(\pi \) to the group... ⁴² The disciples were devoted to the teachings of the apostles, to fellowship, to the breaking of bread, and to prayer... 46 The believers had a single purpose... Acts 2:40-42, 46 (GWT)

WAS THE SECOND GREAT CHURCH PLANTING CHURCH.

NOTE: Acts 13:1-3; 14:26; 15:32-33, 36-40; 18:22-23

- The Jerusalem Church seemed compelled to plant by persecution.
- The Antioch Church seemed compelled to plant by purpose.

WILL BE A GREAT CHURCH PLANTING CHURCH...

THE JERUSALEM AND ANTIOCH CHURCHES.

The believers were scattered by the persecution that began when Stephen was killed. Some of them went as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus, and Antioch. They told the Good News in these places, but only to Jews. Acts 11:19 (ERV)

...the gospel we brought did not come to you in words only, but also with power, with the Holy Spirit, and with deep conviction. Indeed, you know what kind of people we proved to be while we were with you, acting on your behalf. ⁶ You became imitators of us and of the Lord...1 Thessalonians 1:5. 6a (ISV)

THEIR DISCIPLE MAKING EFFECTIVENESS.

When the church at Jerusalem heard what had happened, they sent Barnabas to Antioch to help the new converts. Acts 11:22 (TLB)

The church in Antioch had grown strong, with many prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon (a dark man from Central Africa), Lucius (from Cyrene in North Africa), Manaen (a member of Herod's governing council), and Saul. Acts 13:1 (VOICE)

As a result, you became a model for all the believers in Macedonia and Achaia. 8 From you the word of the Lord has spread out not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place where your faith in God has become known. As a result, we do not need to say anything about it. 1 Thessalonians 1:7.8 (ISV)
