Those who owned fields or houses sold them and brought the price of the sale to the apostles and made an offering of it. The apostles then distributed it according to each person's need. ³⁶⁻³⁷ Joseph, called by the apostles "Barnabas" (which means "Son of encouragement"), a Levite born in Cyprus, sold a field that he owned, brought the money, and made an offering of it to the apostles.
