➤ **WHY IS IT SO VITAL THAT I HAVE AUTHENTIC FAITH?**

1. Because _____

Without faith no one can please God. [L For; Because] Anyone who comes to God must believe that he is real [exists] and that he rewards those who truly want to find [earnestly/sincerely seek] him. Hebrews 11:6 (EXB)

2. Because _____

For every child of God defeats this evil world, and we achieve this victory through our faith. 1 John 5:4 (NLT)

3. Because _____

I said that you will die with your sins unforgiven. If you don't have faith in me for who I am, you will die, and your sins will not be forgiven. John 8:24 (CEV)

4. Because _____

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith... Ephesians 2:8a (NIV)

NOTE: The use of the term “authentic” or “saving” faith clearly indicates the existence of an “_____” and “_____ -saving” kind of faith.

To the man who thinks that faith by itself is enough I feel inclined to say, “So you believe that there is one God? That’s fine. So do all the devils in hell and shudder in terror! James 2: 18, 19 (Phillips)

3. It is the “kind” that _____

For, my dear short-sighted man, can’t you see far enough to realize that faith without the right actions is dead and useless? James 2:20 (Phillips)

So you see that what he believed and what he did were working together. What he did made his faith complete. James 2:22 (NIrV)

- A “complete,” authentic, saving faith combines faith (i.e., my _____) and faithfulness (i.e., my _____).

- Authentic faith is personified in the lives of Abraham and Rahab

Don't you remember that our ancestor Abraham was shown to be right with God by his actions when he offered his son Isaac on the altar? ²² You see, his faith and his actions worked together. His actions made his faith complete. ²³ And so it happened just as the Scriptures say: "Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous because of his faith." He was even called the friend of God. ²⁴ So you see, we are shown to be right with God by what we do, not by faith alone. ²⁵ Rahab the prostitute is another example. She was shown to be right with God by her actions when she hid those messengers and sent them safely away by a different road. James 2:21-25 (NLT)
